- Cahterine Zeta Jones knows many famous people, and her friends include Steven Spielberg and Sean Connery. How did she get on the road to stardom?
- Zeta Jones was born on 25 September 1969 and she grew up in a small village 0 outside Swansea in south Wales. Her mother started taking her to dance classes at the age of five, "I really wanted to be an actress as long as I can remember," she says. "I knew what I wanted to do, and even as a teenager I never had any other job- I just wanted to be on stage."
- Her parents drove her around Wales when she was performing in musicals like ❸ Bugsy Malone. By the time she was 16, she was playing the lead in the London production of the musical 42nd Street. Even then, she was working to reach the top. "Every night after the show, everyone went out. But I knew I had to perform the next night, so I always went home."
- At twenty-one, Zeta Jones had her first taste of fame in a successful British TV series. But her big break came when she went to Los Angeles in 1996.
